University of Toronto-Mississauga (UTM) Academy of Medicine and the Institute for Management & Innovation offer professional graduate programs in biotechnology, innovation and sustainability management.

Located on the UTM campus, is the Centre for Medicinal Chemistry that focuses on the development of new drugs targeting cancer and other diseases.

UTM is also home to SpinUp, a wet lab incubator that supports early-stage life science companies and entrepreneurs offering access to subsidized space including specialized equipment, fumehoods and programming.
